To support our commitment to minimising the environmental impacts of our operations, PwC Australia will:

- Comply with all relevant environmental legislation and regulations.
- Update, implement and annually review our firm's environmental policy.
- Communicate our environmental policy, progress and performance to stakeholders, such as via PwC's external website and in external reports such as the firm's Social Impact report.
- Measure and annually report our greenhouse gas emissions in accordance with Australia's voluntary Climate Active Carbon Neutral network, PwC's global Corporate Reporting processes and, in time, with the Science Based Targets initiative.
- Develop and implement a plan to support our Net Zero 2030 commitment, including providing oversight of our performance by the firm's Net Zero Leader and Net Zero Governance Committee.
- Maintain an employee engagement program to raise awareness and embed environmental responsibility into the way we work with a focus on reducing waste; reusing and recycling; reducing our carbon footprint; and using our skills for environmental impact.
- Provide support, tools, technology and education for our people to reduce their environmental impact.
- Support the environmental charities that are championed by our people through the firm's approved workplace giving platform.
- Reduce our consumption of resources, use resources efficiently and minimise waste in our operations.
- Collaborate with our people, clients, suppliers, landlords and other stakeholders to promote improved environmental performance.
- Consider environmental issues, energy performance and circularity options in the acquisition, design, refurbishment, location, management and use of buildings.
