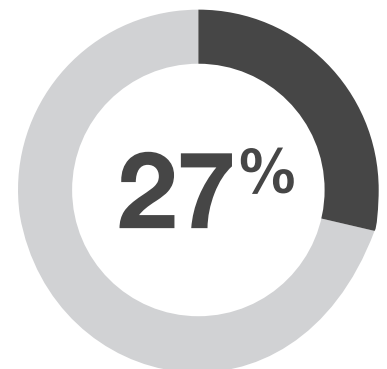
## What value does ISO 27001 add to your business?
