ISO 45001 provides the framework to help organisations manage the safety of their workers, thereby protecting one of their most important assets – their people.

What is ISO 45001?

ISO 45001 is a brand new international standard for Occupational Health and Safety (OH&S) management systems. It harmonises the framework for OH&S risk management across the world, providing a single benchmark for OH&S performance.

Why do we need it?

An organisation's activities can pose a health and safety risk, therefore it is critically important for the organisation to eliminate or minimise OH&S risks by taking appropriate preventive measures. When applied to the OH&S management system effectively, and implemented with appropriate controls, methods and tools, organisations can protect the lives and wellbeing of their workforce, and their business reputation.

What value will ISO 45001 add to your business?

Your organisation is responsible for the health and safety of your workers, your contractors and even your customers, including promoting and protecting their physical and mental health.

The adoption and certification of an occupational health and safety management system enables your organisation to improve its OH&S performance in the enhancement of health and safety at work and to manage its OH&S risks more effectively.

The rates of accidents, injuries, deaths and illnesses to people through their work activities continue to be at an unacceptable level. While this directly affects the individuals that are harmed, it also has consequences for their organisations and the societies within which they live.
