### What is TAPA FSR?

The Facility Security Requirement (FSR) was developed by Transport Asset Protection Association (TAPA) in response to the mounting global theft in supply chains. FSR has become the benchmark, ensuring secure storage and transit of goods.

FSR focuses on the resilience of manufacturing and warehouse facilities in order to minimise the risk of financial and/or cargo loss. However it provides an overview of the entire supply chain security process, and sets out the framework, processes and requirements for organisations to achieve TAPA certification.

### Overview of TAPA FSR

- Was established to ensure the safe and secure transit, storage and warehousing of any TAPA members' assets globally.
- Is the minimum acceptable security standard.
- FSR has 3 levels of security that can be achieved during certification: - A, B or C (A being the highest level of security.)
- The level of certification selected depends on the needs of your clients and business.
