Careers Australia Group Limited and its subsidiaries referred to in Appendix A (All Administrators Appointed) (the Group)

We were appointed joint and several Administrators of the Group on 25 May 2017.

The business and assets of the Group are now under our control as Administrators.

Due to the Group's financial position at the date of our appointment, we do not currently have sufficient funds available to meet payroll and other costs which would allow us to continue trading the Group on a 'business as usual' basis. Accordingly, we hereby confirm you are stood down effective 25 May 2017 whilst we undertake an urgent assessment of the Group. We have notified a limited number of employees who are retained to assist us in assessing the current position of the Group.

You have been stood down without pay until further notice effective immediately. For the avoidance of any doubt, the Administrators do not assume personal liability in respect of any claims arising from the stand down arrangements.

We will be working closely with union representatives and providing regular updates as the administration progresses.

The Administrators will be assessing the financial position of the Group including any possibilities for resuming operations. We will write to all employees early next week to confirm the status of your employment.
